Lesson: K4 – K5

Concept: Learns that the body is a gift from God. Follows Grade Specific Religious Education concept under Creedal Church and Moral Life.

Goals of this lesson: This lesson is designed to assist the child in learning that the body is a gift from God, and to learn ways to keep themselves safe.

Opening Prayer:

Parent: Dear God, I know that you love me. *Child: Dear God, I know that you love me.*

Parent: Dear God, I know that you watch over me. *Child: Dear God, I know that you watch over me.* Parent: Dear God, I know that you keep me safe. *Child: Dear God, I know that you keep me safe.*

ALL: Amen.

Lesson by Parent:

My body is a gift from God. Everyone has a body. Your body belongs to you. You own it. Because it is your body, it is important to keep it safe. Most of the time grownups keep you safe. But there are things you can do to help yourself stay safe.

Pass out the body handout. Have your child color the swim suits.

Explain that the private and special parts of the body are the areas that are covered by the child's bathing suit. These are the parts of the body that belong to only them.

Discuss who are the people who would be allowed to see or touch these parts and why they would need to touch them.


